LUNCH ACCOUNTS:

It is very important that you have adequate lunch money in your child's lunch account. Charging lunch and/or breakfast is not allowed. If you do owe money please pay your bill as soon as possible. Please note: If your child's lunch account balance is below \$5.00 you will get a courtesy notification call. If you do not want to get the notification call you need to have \$5.00 or more in the account, or take the account down to \$ 0.00. Please contact our food service department if you have questions concerning lunch accounts.

KINDERGARTEN ENROLLMENT:

We are still enrolling students for the 2018/2019 kindergarten classes. Screening will be done on May 4. Anyone who needs an enrollment form should stop by the elementary office as soon as possible. Children who will be five years old on or before August 1, 2018, are eligible to enroll.

2018/2019 SCHOOL YEAR:

No sooner do we end one year until we prepare for the next. The first day for students in grades K-5 next year will be August 10, 2018. Elementary Registration Day for students in grades K-5 will be July 18 from 8:30 AM until 11:30 AM, we will break for lunch, and resume from 1:00 PM until 6:00 PM. Online registration will also be available. All students must register for the 18/19 school year. Supply lists for next year will be sent home with students before the end of this school year.

REPORT CARDS: Report cards will be sent home with students on the last day of school.

5th GRADE HONOR DAY:

The awards program for our 5th grade class will be held on May 18 at 10:30 AM in the **high school** gymnasium. Parents are encouraged to attend and support these students as they bring their elementary school experience to a close.

BOOK FEE PAYMENTS:

All book fees should be paid by May 18, 2018. Any outstanding fees will be turned over to the administration office on May 29, 2018. All payments will then need to be paid at the superintendent's office. Online payments are also available.

TRACK & FIELD DAY:

Students will be outside most of the day on Track & Field Day. Please make sure your student has comfortable shoes and appropriate attire. It is possible that there will be dew on the grassy areas where events take place (you might consider sending extra socks/shoes in case students' feet get wet). You may also want to send sunscreen and sunglasses. Water will be provided.
